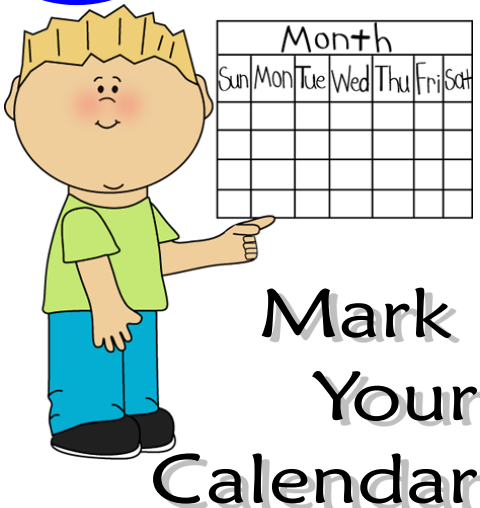
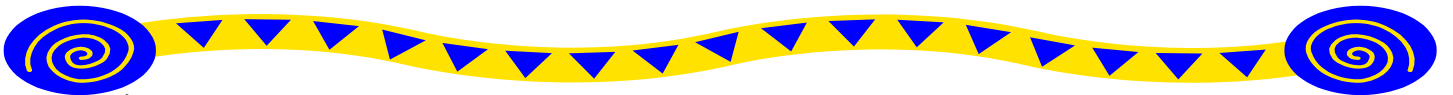
Family Engagement in Transitions



Transition means change. Change can be hard for young children, and adults! Whether your child is changing childcare providers, changing from Early Head Start to a Head Start classroom, changing classrooms or leaving Head Start for kindergarten - you can help make it easier by:

Recruitment continues for the 2021-2022 Head Start (3 & 4 years) and Early Head Start (6 weeks to 3 years) programs. Help us spread the word! Families can call our office (535-6814) to schedule a visit to complete an application.

- Talking about how the new school or childcare will be different. Talk to your child about how they feel about the changes.
- Teaching your child his/her personal information: full name, address & phone number
- Taking a walk around the school grounds over the summer. Let your child play on the playground and even peek in the windows.
- Attending Open House or Meet & Greet. The public school usually hold this just before the 1st day of school. Head Start will mail out a letter in late summer with dates for Open House and Parent Orientation.
